Notes

The Census of 6th June, 1841 was the first UK census to record, on a national scale, a person's first name and surname, age, sex, occupation and 'place' where they were staying on the night in question. House numbers were rarely recorded, being more usual to note only the street name and, in rural areas, only the name of the village or hamlet.

Also, children of age less than 15 years had to have their actual year of birth recorded. For those aged 15 years or above, the norm was to round ages down to the nearest 5 years – e.g. a 42 year old would be recorded as being 40 years' old. However, some enumerators did voluntarily record more individual information.

Tenancy changes appear to occur between the years 1841-1851, 1881-1891 and 1901-1911.

Matters appear to be at odds concerning George Endacott's entries for 1891 and 1901. Those of 1901 are for another George who had been an agricultural labourer at South Tawton in 1871 and a farm bailiff and famer at East Okement in 1881 and 1891.

The enumerations for Fernworthy were carried out under the Tavistock registration district (sub-district Buckland Monachorum) of Lydford Parish from 1841 to 1871, thereafter the sub-district changed to Tavistock. Believing the habitat still occupied up to and including 1928 information for 1921 remains elusive although it has been established that George Mortimore and family were elsewhere by then.
